SEN students

Circle Time (compulsory in all classes):

Children talk individually, use verbal language or body language and prompting on General Knowledge / self-expectation, weather of the day and express their needs and learns phonic through play. Circle time encourages self-expression in students.

Low level, compulsory in all classes that students benefits from: One to one individual attention, Hand approach, Dotted, Using of Flash Cards.

Therapeutic class/ Pre-primary Level

- Learning of basic daily living skills.

- Learning of class rules and expected student behaviour

Grade 1-6

- Follows the national framework curriculum.
- Main subjects; Maths, English, French, Science, History and Geography
- Other subjects: ICT, SSEE, Art, Health and education
- National and PSAC examination same as mainstream school. Our student are supported by reader and having extra time to complete their paper
- Continuous assessment for low level
- Students who succeed at PSAC exams can attend a college.

Rehabilitation/Prevocational

Welcomes students with low academic ability.

Trained in personal hygiene, grooming kitchen tasks, pastry, table setting, household tasks gardening, cleaning and crafts.

The students also receive life skills training which includes functional literacy and numeracy skills, civic education (human and moral values)
